

The School Traveling Truth Booth Program

The Truth Booth School Tour

A ProLife organization or religious organization can purchase a Truth Booth and set up a travelling schedule through area schools. When situated in a prime campus location, students may pause to watch the video images of a developing baby from 8 weeks onward on the 32 inch LCD TV. The display is unmanned, unassuming and non confrontational causing students to think about what they see.

The Truth Booth education program is designed to take the compelling video images of life in the womb beyond their typical use - medical diagnosis and pre-birth photo opportunity - **and into the student conscience.**

Contact & Acceptance

Contact for the Truth Booth Tour is made by the purchasing organization to a school principal, teacher of theology or Campus Minister. Requests from schools are most welcome but must be sanctioned by a school principal or administrator. Once a school decides to participate in the tour, a mutually agreed upon time is set for the school to accept the Truth Booth on its campus.

Time on Campus

The average length of time a high school keeps the Truth Booth on its campus varies from 2 to 6 weeks. There is no set time frame. If the Truth Booth is at a school longer than 3 weeks, we recommend that the unit rotate locations (example: 2 weeks in the cafeteria, 2 weeks in the main lobby, 2 weeks in the library).

Pick up and Delivery

Arrangements for pick up and delivery of the Truth Booth can be made by either the purchasing organization or the school receiving the display. A mutually agreed upon transfer date must be set between the last school displaying the unit and the next school receiving it. The purchasing organization would manage an overall schedule of participating schools.

At least one adult school administrator or teacher is required to be present with two *physically strong* and responsible students for the transfer of the Truth Booth display unit. The Truth Booth unit must be handled with care. It fits into the back end of most mini-vans.

The dimensions of the Truth Booth are: 42" width 38" height 12" depth

We strongly suggest you measure your vehicle beforehand.

Fees

There are no fees required from high schools to display the Truth Booth. Some schools have incorporated service projects or baby showers to raise money for local Pregnancy Resource Centers.

Fetal Development Literature

The sponsoring organization should provide free take-away literature showing fetal development that should be displayed with the Truth Booth. Contact information for a local Pregnancy Resource Center should be provided on the back.

Publicity

We respectfully request the right to display photographs of students standing near the Truth Booth on school campuses while on display. Please send us photos with the name and location of the school. The names of students are not to be provided.
